

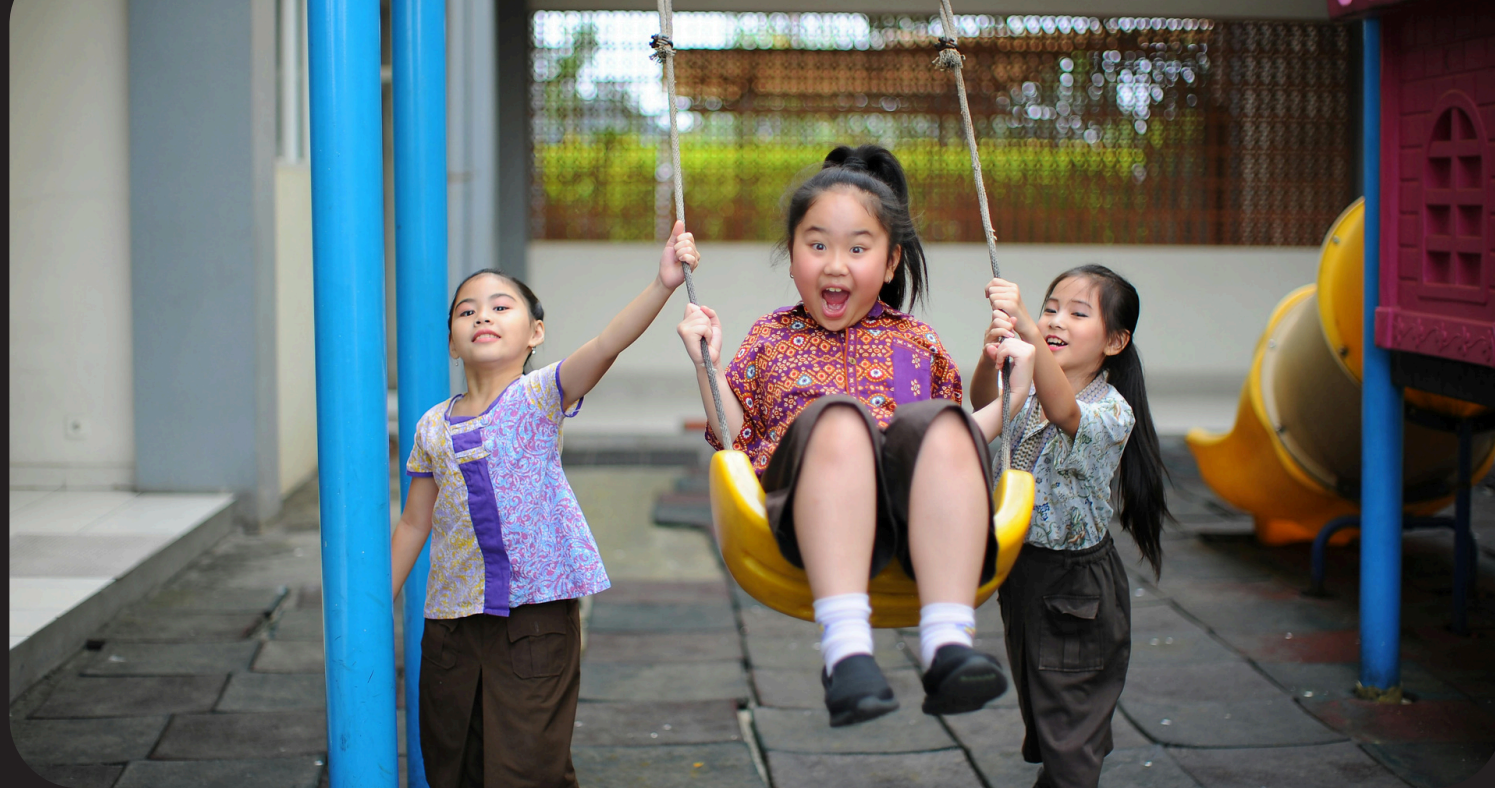

Inspection Methodology

Inspections of public children's playgrounds and recreation areas are carried out at three levels in accordance with European safety standards (**LVS EN 1176**, **LVS EN 1177**, **EN 16630**, etc.), Latvian regulations, and guidelines for ensuring safety requirements.

Regular and systematic inspections are necessary to ensure area safety, operational compliance, and long-term usability.





Three Levels of Inspection

- Regular routine check-ups
- Operational inspections
- Annual main inspections



Regular Routine Check-Ups



Performed regularly (daily or several times per week) to detect visible damage, identify contamination, and detect consequences of vandalism. Inspection frequency depends on workload of the area, location, and environmental and operational factors.



Results are recorded in:



Results are recorded in inspection logs, inspection sheets, and survey lists.





Operational Inspection

Systematic and periodic inspections involving an in-depth assessment of equipment condition, operational safety, wear and tear, stability, and consequences of vandalism.

Inspection intervals: once per month or at least once every 3 months.



Annual Main Inspection

- Comprehensive inspection assessing overall safety level, equipment condition, surface condition, wear and damage, structural issues, and changes in safety level.
- During inspection, measurements are taken and compliance with European safety standards is assessed.
- After inspection, a detailed report is prepared and corrective recommendations are provided.
